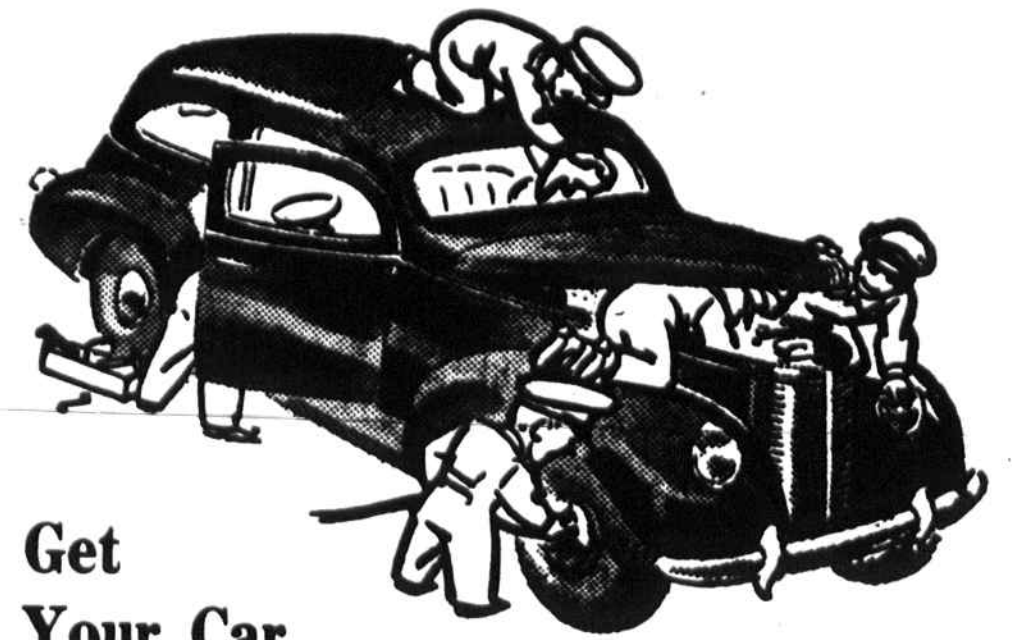

**OPA Demands That We Follow Instructions Below: In Handling Gasoline Rationing Coupons Always - -**

1. Always ask for Rationing Book before delivering gasoline.
2. Always be sure correct Ration Sticker is properly displayed on the vehicle.
3. Always be sure the vehicle is the same as described on the Ration Book cover.
4. Always detach Coupons from the book.
5. Always see that Coupons are endorsed as follows: A, B, C, D, and T Coupons (except those issued to fleets) **Must Show On Front Of Coupons.**

(1) Vehicle number and State of Registration.  
B, C, D and T Coupons issued to fleets **Must Show On Front Of Coupons.**

- (1) Name and address of fleet operator showing State and Town (or)
- (2) Certificate of War Necessity number and State and Town (or)
- (3) License number of vehicle and State.

**E Coupons Must Show On Front.**

- (1) Name and address of Ration holder plain written.
