Reemployment Rights Continued By Extension

Of Selective Service Act Secretary of Labor Maurice J. Tobin announced today that inductees, enlistees and reservists who leave jobs in private industry or with the Federal Government to perform active service in the armed forces are eligible for reemployment rights as a result of Public Laws 572 and 599, 81st Congress, which extend the Selective Service Act of 1948 until July 9, 1951.
