

NEW POWER PLANT - On the banks of the Neuse near Goldsboro, North Carolina, is arising a 200,000 horsepower steam electric generating plant of the Carolina Power & Light Company. This is an architect's drawing of the plant as it will appear with two 100,000 horsepower units. Much of the steel work has been completed already.

The first 100,000 horsepower unit is due to go into production by mid-1951, the second unit a year later. Together with the new Lumberton plant of the Company, it will provide 60 per cent more power for the company than it generated in 1949.


