**Buncombe Countys**  
Huge Debt.

Owes \$3,572,000—Yearly Interest \$289,000. Pays More Interest—Twice as much—as Mitchell's Tax List.

"Buncombe County owes exactly \$3,572,000 for bonded indebtedness and during the present year will pay on the bonds, principal and interest a total of \$289,463.75, according to figures compiled by Auditor Duckett.

The money will be paid over for the fiscal year ending, November 30th, 1923, as follows: December, 1922, \$21,050 (already paid); 1923, January, \$19,630; February, \$6,497; March, \$59,621.50; April, \$57,830; May, \$24,325; June, \$95,475; July, \$3,585; August, \$4,497.50; September, \$58,078.75; October, \$4,460. and November, \$10,350

The interest to be paid on the bonds this year amounts to \$193,463.75, while the bonds to be retired amount to \$96,000. There are outstanding 15 issues of road and bridge bonds amounting to \$2,195,000; four funding issues, totalling, \$757,000; three refunding issues, totalling \$198,000; and other issues as follows. Courthouse bonds \$50,000; County Home bonds, \$20,000, jail bonds \$32,000, and childrens home bonds, \$25,000.
