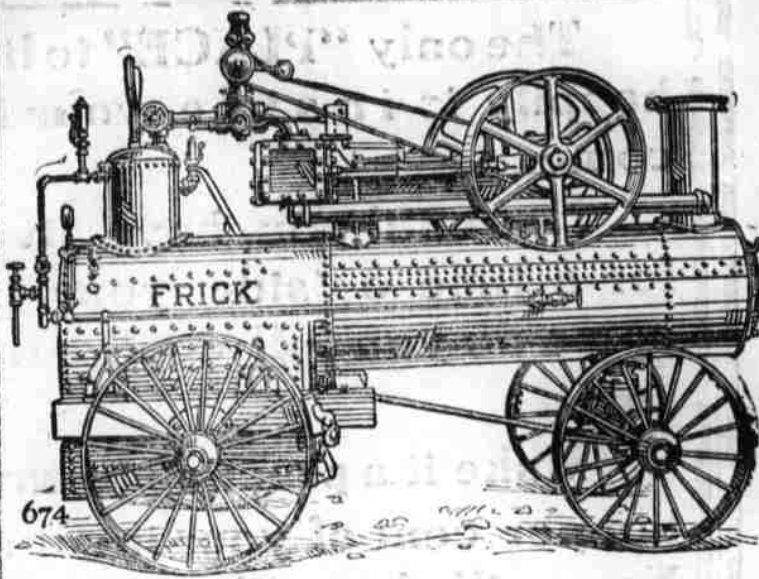
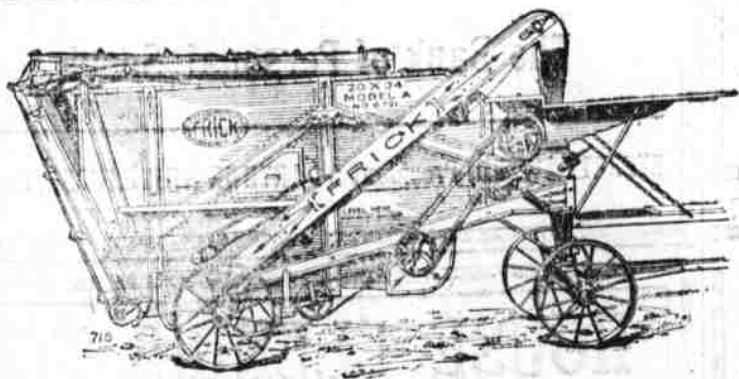

NEW ORLEANS, LA., APRIL 10-13, 1923.
