

The training includes instruction in drill, bayonet training, physical conditioning, parades and ceremonies and other military subjects.


Three weeks are devoted to the rifle range, where recruits fire the M-14 rifle and receive instruction in other basic Marine infantry weapons.

"I WAS getting good tobacco yields but decided last year to see if the Agrico Program could make them better," says Claude J. Wild of Rte. 4, Marshall (Madison Co.), N. C. "When my Agrico Soil Test Report came back, I followed the fertilizer recommendations as closely as possible, using 1,200 lbs. of Agrico for Tobacco 3-9-9 per acre along on the row on half the field. For comparison, I followed my usual program on the rest of the field.

"The Agrico-fertilized tobacco produced 2,670 lbs. of burley per acre, which sold for an average of \$69 a hundred. I figure my income with Agrico was at least \$125 more per acre than with my old program. And since my 10-year average is 2,200 lbs. per acre, the Agrico crop was by far the best tobacco I have ever grown."
