

Vote Called On Turkey Order

A referendum of turkey growers will be held through ASCS county offices June 18 through June 22. The vote, according to Ralph W. Ramsey, County ASCS Office Manager, will be for or against the National marketing order for turkeys.

If the order is made effective by the Secretary as a result of grower approval by at least two-thirds of those voting in the referendum, by number or by volume of production, it will be the first marketing order program to be operated on a nationwide basis for any farm commodity.

The order is designed to provide the industry with means by which the marketing of turkeys can be adjusted so as to assure fair returns to producers and reasonable prices to consumers.

The referendum will be conducted in all states — except Alaska and Hawaii, to which the proposed order does not apply — by State and County Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation

(ASC) Committees.

Cooperative associations desiring to vote for their members must qualify not later than June 12, 1962, with the ASCS state office in the state where the Associations' principal places of business are located. Cooperative associations which thus qualify will be required to attach their ballots lists, by counties, showing the names and addresses and marketings for 1961 of the members for whom they vote.

Voters, along with indicating whether they favor or do not favor the proposed order, must show on their ballots their volume of marketings in 1961.

Ballots will be mailed to all known eligible producers and will also be available in county ASCS offices. Ballot boxes will be located in the county offices and ballots may be cast in person or by mail.

Voting will begin June 18. Ballots must be delivered to the proper polling places not later than June 22, and ballots must be post-
