and senior divisions in physical and biological science divisions. In the junior division, projects may be presented by one, two, or three persons, and the district judging is final. Senior division projects are to be presented by one person only, and the five top winners in each category will be eligible for entrance in the State Science Fair to be held at the University of North Carolina on April 9 and 10.

Hirt said that certain regulations are set by the North Carolina Academy of Science and apply in all districts. Students may enter directly from their own schools where no local fairs are held, and entry forms should be submitted to the district director at least seven days prior to the district event.
