Termites Can Be Controlled With Work And Effort

This is the time of year to be on the lookout for termites. Not all flying ants are termites. The best way to tell termites from ants are not as long as the front ones and an ant has a wasp waist. In termites, all four wings are the same size. (2) The termites have a thick body from the wings back about the same size.

Be on the look out for fakers in the termite control business. Many people in this area have paid as much as \$600 to have their property termite proofed only to find out that their four year guarantee which they received is from a non-existent organization with a fake address and that their premises were simply sprayed with oil. If you have a termite control organization protect your property, make sure it is from a reputable, well known organization and not one of these fly-by-nights.

It is a rather simple matter to protect your property yourself, if you are willing to exert a little of your time and labor. Chlordane, aldrin, or hyptachlor all give good protection for several years. For further information, contact your county agent's office.

Heifer Raising On Contract Basis Is Working Out Well

Lon Sluder, a dairyman of the Little Pine community, turned his heifer raising business over to another man on a contract basis about two years ago. Mr. Sluder has just got back his first heifers and is well pleased with the way this arrangement has worked out. Contract raising of heifers started about five years ago in the eastern part of the state and has worked out, in most cases, very well. This relieves the dairyman of the responsibility of raising, placements and allows him to spend more time on the feeding and management of his milking herd. The standard contract calls for the heifer raiser to take the calf when it is three days of age and raising it to at least two years of age, returning it to the dairyman ready to freshen. The price varies throughout the state from \$200 to \$270 and in most
