Precinct No. 6 — Hot Springs (formerly precinct 9) — Hot Springs Public School.

Precinct No. 7 — Ebbs Chapel (formerly precincts 11, 16) — Ebbs Chapel Public School.

Precinct No. 8 — Spring Creek (formerly precincts 8, 13, 22) — Spring Creek Public School.
