

**International Sunday School Lesson**

FOR MARCH 11, 1973  
 LESSON TEXT:  
 GENESIS 1:27-30; 4:1-9;  
 MATTHEW 25:31-46;  
 ACTS 17:30-31;  
 ROMANS 14:18-12.

This Lesson seeks to define the responsibility of the truly avowed Christian towards God, when the Christian believer fully acknowledges the amnesty granted by the Father towards the sinner, through the blood of Jesus Christ.

Man, created in God's own image, provided for as no other creatures were provided for in His marvellous scheme of things, nevertheless has continually fallen short of His expectations, and shirked the responsibilities laid upon him by the Lord.

Sinning thus, we forfeited the promise of eternal life in His presence, yet He has not turned His back on us. Instead, we have been offered a remedy for our sinfulness, and a means of restoration of lost privileges if we will but embrace His ordinances in full repentance and unswerving faith and devotion.

Man is a responsible being; the Bible stresses this fact over and over again, throughout its pages. He and he alone is solely responsible for his actions. He may hold himself accountable to no one, but he is accountable to God.

Man's responsibilities are many: endowed with the gift of procreation, he can insure the continuance of life on earth for generations to come, endowed with health and the ability to reason, he is to be a keeper of the earth, tending it so that may bring forth the fruits that sustain life. He is to be a responsible citizen, and give of himself ungrudgingly in service to his fellow man. He is to be a responsible parent, and have a care for his children, less fortunate than he, so that he may conduct himself in a way that will be a credit to his Father, God.

Man's greatest yes, but a no, is to himself. For, in following his Christian responsibilities, he will not neglect his spiritual and moral building, always, that may bring forth strength that will so ardently desire His salvation to have.

Man's Christian growth is not to be bound up in his own self. As we pour out ourselves in service to others, so will we be replenished from within, by His grace.

Today's world certainly provides fertile soil for the Christian who earnestly strives to give of himself in service. Today's youth, riotous and rebelling against discipline of any kind, inclines to run in herds, doing the "in" thing, all too often they are "turned on" and "tuned out" as they go methodically about the business of ruining their lives. Yes, the need for mature judgment and earnest effort on the part of true believers is very apparent.

There are few places in the world today that have not experienced the terror and the waste of vandalism and force. Some, civic-minded and community conscious, have devised "half-way houses" and "hot lines" that evidence a reaching out to those in need. Surely the church—the House of God—must busy itself in its work!
