Taylor Praises POWs

Now that U. S. participation in the Vietnam war has almost ended and our American prisoners are returning home, I think it is an appropriate time to express our appreciation to the POW's and to all others who fought in this difficult and unpopular war.

On behalf of myself and the citizens of the 11th Congressional District of North Carolina, I am today placing in the Congressional Record the following statement:
"Over the past eight years, all of us have been touched by the hopes and hardships of the families of the American Prisoners of War. We are proud of the courage with which they have endured countless hardships and disappointments. Now we rejoice with them at the freedom finally won for their husbands, sons, brothers, and fathers."

"The sacrifices these prisoners have been called upon to make have been made with deep respect for America. We should be grateful as a nation for their service and total dedication to God, family and country. We know that these men will be facing many problems in the future months and years ahead in adjusting back to normal life. We must be ready not just to welcome them back, but to lend a helping hand at many points along the way as they return to the land they love and for which they sacrificed so much."

"I have written or called each of them to let them know that I and my office will be available to them for any assistance that can be provided in resolving problems.
"As we welcome back and pay tribute to our Prisoners of War who have served their country under difficult circumstances, let us not forget the more than 1300 men still missing in Southeast Asia and the continued bravery of their families; nor the more than 46,000 Americans who made the supreme sacrifice; nor the 200,000 others who have been wounded, many of whom are in our Veterans Administration Hospitals, nor the many other men who served with honor in Vietnam. By the sacrifice of these men in a strange land in behalf of an alien people, they have helped strengthen the position of the free world."

"I have been pleased to note that some of the counties and towns in my District are celebrating the return of our Prisoners of War and are planning future programs paying tribute to those who are wounded and missing in action and those who were killed in action."

"In some parts of this nation it is not fashionable these days to honor our fighting men. Some people have been so much against the unpopular war in Vietnam that they show no appreciation to the men who served there. The very word "patriot" has almost disappeared from respectable use. It has somehow become sophisticated and liberal and altogether cool to dwell incessantly upon the tragic mistakes that are a part of any war, but thank God, I believe that the people of Western North Carolina know what the word "patriotism" means and realize that this country is truly a great country."

61 Boaters Killed In 1972

Sixty-one people were killed while boating on North Carolina waters last year. This is a marked increase over the 39 lives lost while boating in 1971. The figures recently released by the North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission's Division of Motorboats and Water Safety also reveal that people falling overboard and boats capsizing were the major causes of deaths on the water.

When asked what could be done to reduce the number of boating fatalities, a spokesman for the Commission stated that boating fatalities could be reduced by 25 percent if comprehensive and proper education and proper maintenance were given boating safety training.
