STATEMENT OF RESULT OF SPECIAL ELECTION HELD IN THE TOWN OF MARS HILL.

ON JUNE 26, 1973
Whereas, by the direction of the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Mars Hill, in the state of North Carolina, a special election was duly called and held in said town on June 26, 1973, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of said town the question hereinafter set forth, and the said Board of Aldermen has received from the interim municipal board of elections of the Town of Mars Hill a certification of the result of the election, and has determined the result of said election to be as hereinafter stated; now therefore,
The Board of Aldermen hereby makes the following statement of the result of said election pursuant to the local government Bond Act:

(1) The number of voters registered and qualified to vote at said election was 544.
(2) The number of votes cast at said election "for the ordinance authorizing \$90,000 of bonds of the Town of Mars Hill to finance the improvement of the system maintained by the town for the supply and distribution of water by the construction of a storage tank and construction of water mains and transmission and distribution lines within the corporate limits of the town and without the corporate limits of the town for a distance not exceeding one mile, including the acquisition and installation of the equipment, machinery and apparatus required therefor and the acquisition of the necessary land or rights-in-land and a tax therefor" was 156. The total number of votes cast "against" said bonds and tax was 2. The question in the form submitted was approved by the affirmative vote of a majority of those who voted thereon at said election.

Any action or proceeding challenging the regularity or validity of this bond referendum must be begun within 30 days after July 12, 1973.
