"There will be those who will say this plan doesn't go far enough," Holshouser said. "There will be those who will say that government should establish more rules and force people to abide by them.

"Maybe we will have to do that farther down the road. If the General Assembly gives the governor emergency powers to deal with the fuel shortage, I won't hesitate to use them if that becomes absolutely necessary, Holshouser said. "We may even see the time when the federal government imposes coupon rationing." In addition to the major

steps outlined, Holshouser, also renewed his plea that

residents organize car pools for their traveling. He urged that motorists make a special effort to cut their driving mileage by 25 per cent from what it was last year. And, he urged residents to take vacations within North Carolina this summer.
