AMERICA'S HERITAGE

HIGHLIGHTS OF AMERICAN HISTORY
GENERAL HERKIMER AT THE BATTLE OF ORISKANY

The British were campaigning toward Albany, N.Y., in an ambitious plan to crush the American forces there. Each step of the way, however, the Red Coats faced courageous militiamen ready to defend their homes, villages, and farms.

The Battle of Oriskany typified the rallying of American patriots attempting to defend their homesteads from British occupation. Upon hearing the British were coming, some 800 hardy countrymen in the Mohawk Valley quickly assembled under General Nicholas Herkimer. On August 3, 1777, the German-American militiamen marched from the mouth of Oriskany Creek toward Fort Schuyler, where the British had launched their latest siege.

The undisciplined patriots, moving irregularly and without precaution, were entirely unconscious of an ambush staged by the British and their Indian allies in a deep ravine. The whole body of provincials, except the rear guard, descended into the ravine. The circle closed as the war whoop

sounded. Spears, hatchets and deadly rifle balls fell upon the patriots. The sudden onslaught caused great confusion, but the Americans quickly recovered to fight with the courage and skill of veteran troops.

As the battle raged on, a musket ball killed General Herkimer's horse. The general's left leg was shattered just below the knee. With valiant composure, he demanded that the saddle be taken from the dead horse and placed against a large beech tree.

Seated there, with his men falling like autumn foliage, and the bullets of the enemy whistling around him, the intrepid general calmly gave his orders. This incredible scene is vividly recaptured in a painting by F.C. Yohn entitled "General Herkimer at the Battle of Oriskany," a part of the historical paintings collection owned by The Continental Insurance Companies.

The battle continued for hours. The Americans fought hard and long until reinforcements came to the rescue, saving the area from British occupation. General Herkimer died ten days later from wounds suffered in the battle.
