Co., for collecting about 25,000 aluminum cans. The school also received an award for collecting the most cans of any middle school in Coca Cola's Skyland district, covering Madison, Buncombe, Hender-

son and Haywood Counties. The money went to cut student costs of the school yearbook, Haynie said.

The board also considered four applicants for the part-time secretary position in Town Hall, but took no action pending the special called meeting on Thursday.

Under questioning from both the aldermen and reporters, Wild said that neither the police chief position or the part-time secretary position had been publicly advertised.

The aldermen also approved a health insurance plan for town employees that will cost Marshall an estimated \$4,043.52 per year. Town employees currently have no fringe benefits.


Under the plan approved by the aldermen, all eight town employees will be covered by a Blue Cross-Blue Shield plan offered to Madison County employees. Marshall workers will be added to the policy for county workers at a cost of \$42.12 per month for each employee.

Town employees would be required to pay an additional \$74.53 per month for coverage of family members. Marshall employees to be covered by the plan include Bill Plemons, Charlie Sexton, Autrey Black, Dennis Ledford, Linda Dodson and police officers Chris Bowman and Mike Beasley.

The board also approved a contract with John Reed to paint the streets after construction on the Hill Street sewer project is completed and agreed to hire Bud Roberts to cut grass at the City Cemetery and along Hill Street.


Sammy Lunsford reported that the line to Roberts Hill Rd. was completed and that hookups to homes should be finished by next week.

Marion Wallin reported on progress in the community development beautification program. She told the board that Marshall will be judged in county-wide competition with Greater Ivy, Mars Hill and Upper Laurel on Aug. 13. The meeting was adjourned at 9:15 p.m.
