GREY TO WRITE HIS MEMOIRS In a little village in Holland is the ex-hunter, the man who started the war that has caused the world more anguish than anything in its history.

But the man who tried to avert the war—Sir Edward Grey, the British foreign secretary now Viscount Grey of Fallodon—is preparing a volume of memoirs which should be one of the most notable contributions to European diplomatic and political history for many generations past.

The former foreign secretary has grown almost totally blind and is learning all over again how to read by the sense of touch. Except his friends, few nowadays hear or know anything about the man whose activity once attracted the attention of the world.

Political misfortune, but approaching blindness even more, hastened his disappearance from active public life. Fate brought tragedy into his life long before he became perhaps the greatest figure in European chancelleries.

He was deeply devoted to his wife, a companion to him in his fishing trips and other outdoor excursions. She was injured in a runaway accident in 1906 and died. The blow has left its mark. Always of a retiring disposition, the foreign secretary became more so under the poignancy of this domestic tragedy.

A short time before the war a brother was killed by a lion in Africa. In the early days of the war his nephew, who would have become heir to the title of viscount, which was conferred on him when government changes saw him depart from the foreign office, was killed. The title, therefore, may lapse with the death of the first viscount. Grey himself, for he has no children.

But late had another blow to cut. Some months ago five broke out in his Northumberland house, and had it not been for some neighbors of his munificence and other material being collected for his forthcoming volume would have perished in his study.—Boston Globe.
