Price Trend Still Continues Downward

Dunlinee Still Predominate in Comprehensive List of Wholesale Commodity Quotations. That the downward trend of commodity prices is still sharply defined is evidenced by Dun's comprehensive list of wholesale quotations, which shows 29 recessions this week and only 25 advances.

Winchester, Va., Feb. 20.—A blizzard, ranging throughout the Shenandoah and Cumberland valleys was threatening to block railroads and highways, railroad agents were informed tonight in reports from over the territory.

The storm started with snowfall early Saturday evening and with an intermingling of rain and hail has left a coating of sleet and snow from twelve to fifteen inches deep over the ground.

The temperature was reported rapidly falling and small fruits, which had been encouraged by the spring-like weather of the last few weeks to send forth buds, are believed to have been nipped and newly made gardens destroyed.
