Red Springs, Oct. 20.—President C. G. Vardell, of Flora Macdonald College, has received the following letter:

"Jebbies Court, Holyport Near Maidenhead, Berks, England.
"29 Sept. 1923.
"Sir:
"I was interested to see in "The Daily Mail" that shortly you will be celebrating centenary of Flora Macdonald College, Red Springs, North Carolina. I should be much obliged if you would favor me with some particulars concerning the history of said college. I believe Flora Macdonald lived in Carolina at a place called Lafayetteville, and for a Loyalist Regt. in the War of Independence, and afterwards she and her husband returned to Scotland. But I should like to know how and where this college was built and what it has to do with Flora Macdonald, as I am writing a book called "Some Forgotten Loyalists," dealing with the War of Independence in which I mention Flora Macdonald among other Loyalists.
"I am a descendant of Sir William Johnson Warraghagey, and so am much interested in all this early colonial history. I hope the book will be published next spring.
