

T. L. Gerald Property Is Sold At Auction

The sales tables on South Wilson avenue, between Broad and Cumberland streets, belonging to the estate of the late T. L. Gerald were sold at auction yesterday and bid in by J. C. and S. M. Byrd for \$21,030. The building fronts 78 1-2 feet on Wilson avenue and runs back 140 feet.

The 10-room residence of the late Mr. Gerald, on West Broad street and McKay avenue, was also sold. It was bid in by Nathan M. Johnson at \$12,800. The lot upon which this residence is situated front 140 feet on Broad street and 150 feet on McKay avenue.

The sales were conducted by the Atlantic Coast Realty Company for N. A. Townsend and R. L. Gortwin, commissioners. However, the sales have to be confirmed by the courts before the deeds of transfer can be issued. If the bids are not raised within ten days from date of sale, the sale will be asked to confirm the sales made yesterday.

Steel rail mills of the country, with one exception, are booked to capacity until next June. Railroads are expected to place between 20,000 and 25,000 cars and considerable tonnage of track fastening.

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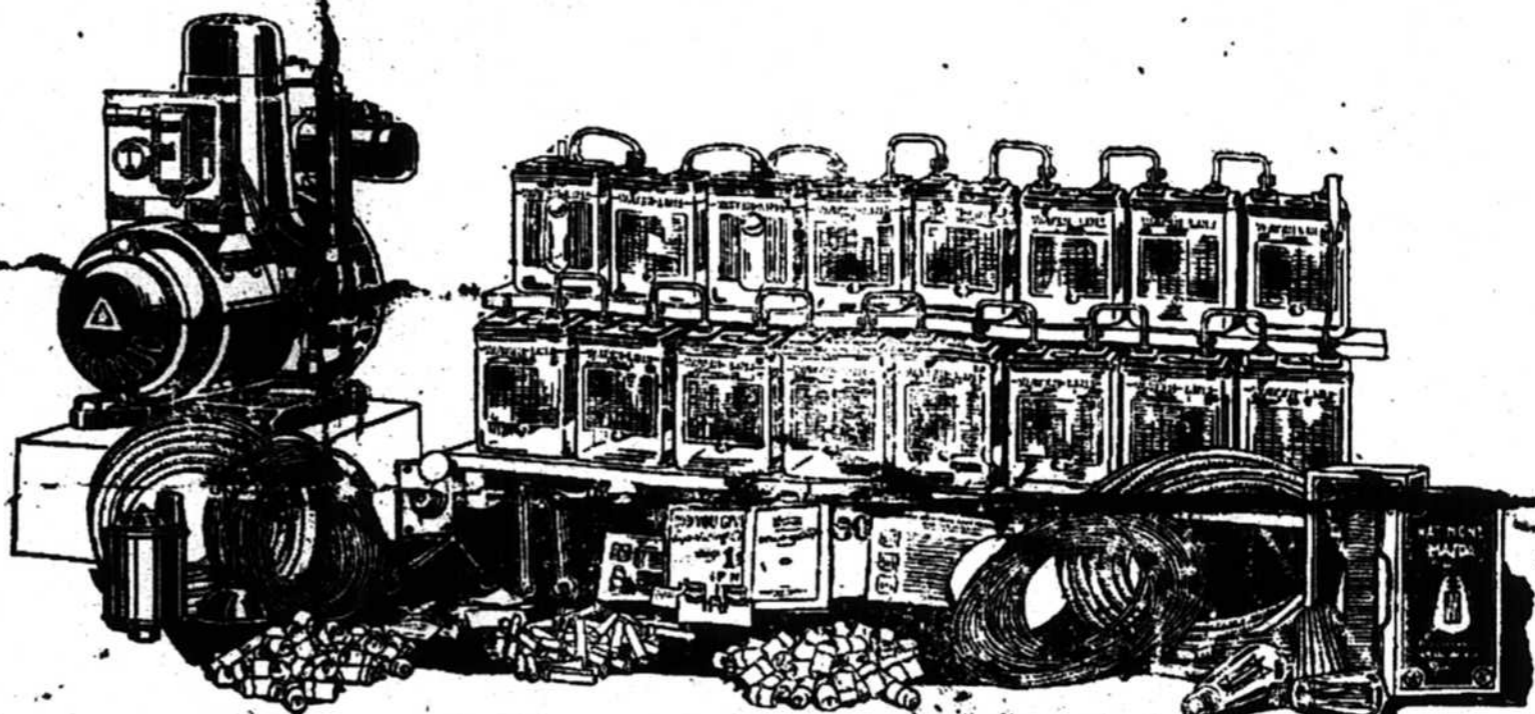
