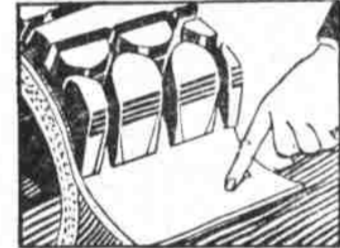

## Denies Confession



Paul H. Young, a prominent citizen of Hazelwood, N. C., has denied a confession which he had made in a newspaper article published in the Mountain News on March 28, 1935. The article stated that Young had confessed to the murder of Dr. Fritz Gebhardt, a prominent citizen of Hazelwood, N. C., who was killed on November 12, 1934. Young stated that he had never seen Gebhardt and that he had no knowledge of his whereabouts at the time of the murder.

### RECORD AT STATE PRISON

For the second time this year, the North Carolina State Prison has reached a new high level. On March 28, according to Oscar Pitts, acting warden of the State Prison, the number of prisoners had reached 8,527. This is the highest number of prisoners since the prison was opened in 1904. The increase in the number of prisoners is due to a combination of factors, including a decrease in the number of prisoners who are released on parole and a decrease in the number of prisoners who are released on probation.
