will sound the warning in Waynesville and the whistle of Unagusta in Hazelwood. Dates of all blackouts will be announced later.

Mr. Rogers had drawn up an ordinance covering blackouts and air drills, and a copy was presented to the mayors and representatives of the towns and adopted for use by them.

While the state guard cannot act as a body except at the direct call of the governor, due to their training in handling arms, they are volunteering as individuals their services when possible to assist in any way. In Canton, they will handle the traffic.

It was also recommended that classes for home nursing be organized among the high school girls so that they might learn to care for the sick during epidemics and for the ill and wounded in homes.

Mr. Rogers stated that a meeting of the air raid wardens of the towns would be called in the near future to draft final plans after which the public would be notified of the drills and given specific instructions as to what is expected. The American Legion was selected as a working medium for drills and blackouts.
