Construction Limitation Order

The Civilian Production Administration and the National Housing Administration have just released jointly the following information builders and prospective home builders: Effective March 26, 1946, and M started prior to March 26th may be completed without permission. A) started means "work on which materials that are to be an integral parts the structure have been incorporated into the structure on the site and which is being carried on at the time of issuance of the order." The order does not apply to construction, repair, or installation jobs on which the of does not exceed the allowance listed below.

Allowance Exemptions

1. Houses designed for occupancy by five or fewer families. * farm houses or other structures, such as a garage, on residential proper 2. Hotel, resort, apartment house or other residential building be

signed for occupancy by more than five families, \$1,000. 3. Commercial or service establishments, such as office, store, gard

theater, warehouse, radio station, gas service station, \$1,000. Farm buildings, excluding farm houses, \$1,000.

5. Church, hospital, school, public buildings, charitable institution

\$1,000. 6. Factory, plant, or other industrial structure used for manufacture

ing, processing, or assembling; logging and lumber camp, utility structure gas of petroleum refining or distribution except service stations

Other structures not listed in above general classes, \$200.

Authorization for Work Above Dollar Limits Application for construction jobs costing more than allowide amount will be handled as follows:

1. For housing jobs, use Form CPA-4386, file with FHA. Greenship and farm housing applications are filled out on the same form, and D with AAA office, County Court House.

2. For farm buildings other than housing, application on a (PA is) should be filed with the AAA office.

3. For all other construction or repair work, application on a (ra form should be filed with the CPA, Greensboro.

No person may sell or deliver materials which he knows or has reas to believe will be used in work prohibited under this order, nor may person either carry on or participate in work prohibited by this order.
