Vitamin C in Cabbage

Tests at several state experiment stations show that cooked cabbage, held over hot water an hour to keep It warm for serving, loses 70 to 80 per cent of the vitamin C it had when freshly cooked, and in two hours loses 90 per cent. Freshly cooked cabbage contains only about half the vitamin C of raw cabbage. Cooked cabbage held in the refrigerafor two or three days and then reheated does not lose as much C as that kept standing on the stove for an hour or two.
