\$35,000 STREET IMPROVEMENT
BONDS**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board
of Aldermen of the Town of Hazel-
wood:
Section 1. That the Town of Hazel-
wood issue its bonds, pursuant to
the Municipal Finance Act, 1921,
as amended, in an amount not ex-
ceeding \$35,000 for the purpose of
constructing or reconstructing the
surface of streets in said Town, in-
cluding the contemporaneous con-
struction or reconstruction of side-
walks, curbs, gutters or drains, and
including grading.
Section 2. That a tax sufficient to
pay the principal and interest of
said bonds shall be annually levied
and collected.
Section 3. That a statement of the
debt of the Town has been filed
with the clerk and is open to public
inspection.
Section 4. That this ordinance
shall take effect when approved by
the voters of the Town at an elec-
tion as provided by law.
The foregoing ordinance was
passed on the 4th day of March,
1947 and was first published on the
11th day of March, 1947.
Any action or proceeding ques-
tioning the validity of said ordi-
nance must be commenced within
thirty days after its first publica-
tion.

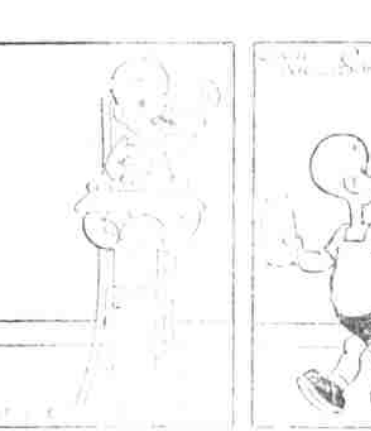
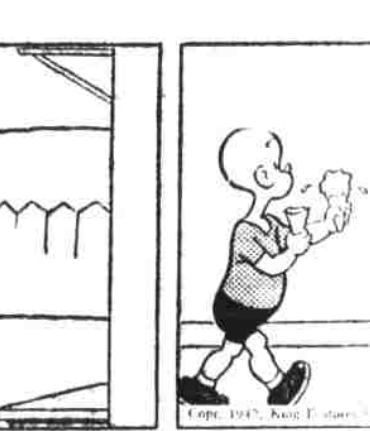
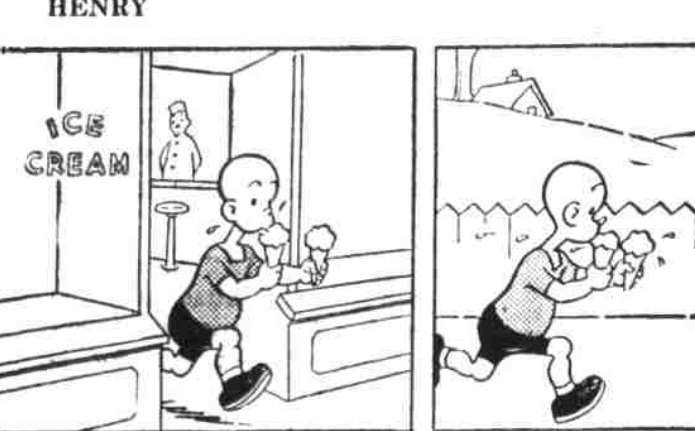
