SAYS FARMERS GOUGED

ATLANTA (AP) — Commissioner of Agriculture Tom Linder made public a letter from the Chilean Nitrate Sales Corporation, charging that small dealers are gouging southern farmers by kiting the price of nitrate fertilizer. W. E. Mathews, regional manager of the nitrate company said small dealers were charging from \$75 to \$80 a ton for nitrate due to the shortage, whereas the price should be no more than \$50 to \$55.
