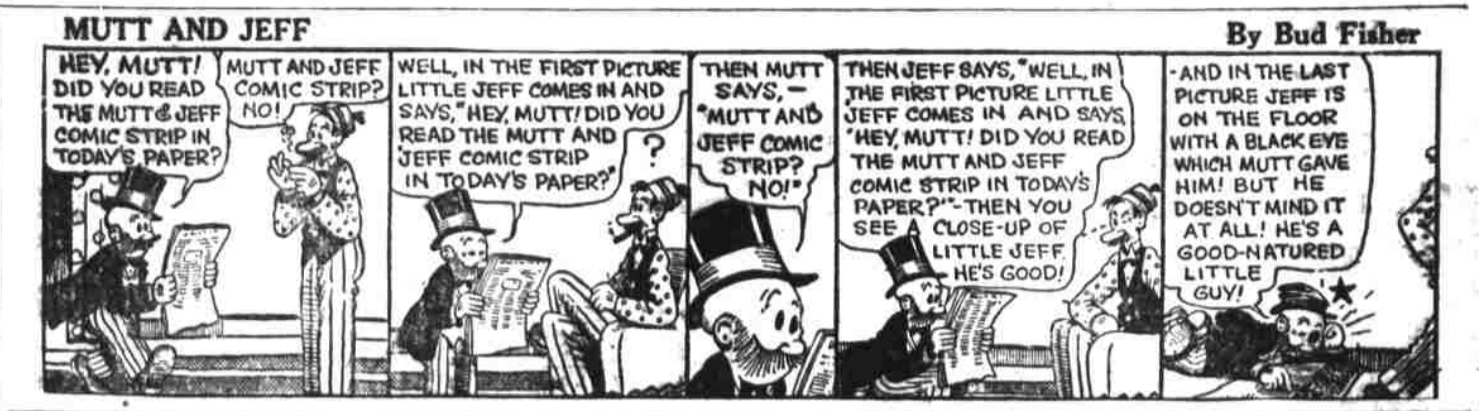

NOTICE INVITING BIDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SCHOOL BUILDING FOR COLORED STUDENTS IN CANTON GRADED SCHOOL DISTRICT, BEAVERDAM TOWNSHIP, HAYWOOD COUNTY.

All licensed contractors will take notice that the Board of Commissioners of the County of Haywood and the Trustees of Canton Graded School District hereby give notice of the intention to construct a school building in Canton Graded School District, Beaverdam Township, Haywood County, (known as Reynolds School for Colored Students) and that bids are invited from licensed contractors for the construction thereof; said contractors may bid in one of two ways, or both, as follows:

1. Bid for the construction of said building, may bid on the building as a whole, or on the plumbing and heating, electrical work, and the general work separately, on a straight firm bid for the contract to furnish all labor and materials for a complete construction job for the work bid on, the contractor to furnish all labor and materials at his own expense, together with all other expenses incidental to the construction thereof.

2. The licensed contractor may offer the proposal or bid in all of the above named methods.

Plans and specifications of the proposed work and the supplies, materials and equipment may be had at any time after date hereof at the Office of Lindsay M. Gudger, Architect, at 52 Carter Street, Telephone 1118, Asheville, North Carolina.

All bids or proposals shall be sealed and accompanied by a cash deposit or a certified check on some bank or trust company authorized to do business in this State in an amount equal to not less than two per cent. of the proposal or bid.

The sealed proposals or bids shall be delivered to George A. Brown, Jr., Chairman of the Board of Commissioners, at Waynesville, North Carolina, not later than 4:00 P. M., Thursday, August 18, 1947, which said bids will be publicly opened in the Commissioners Room in the Courthouse at Waynesville, North Carolina, at the above date and hour.

The Board of Commissioners and the School Trustees reserve the right to reject any and all bids or proposals.

If the Board of Commissioners and the School Trustees accept any proposal or bid, then the successful contractor, or contractors, shall give bond as provided by law for the faithful performance of the contract, which bond shall be in writing and meet the requirements of the laws of North Carolina and the approval of the Commissioners and the Trustees.

This notice is given pursuant to the general statutes of North Carolina and a public local or private law enacted at the session of the General Assembly of North Carolina in 1947, which Act enabled the Board of Commissioners of Haywood County and the Trustees of Canton Graded School District to construct said building on a cost basis plus commission.

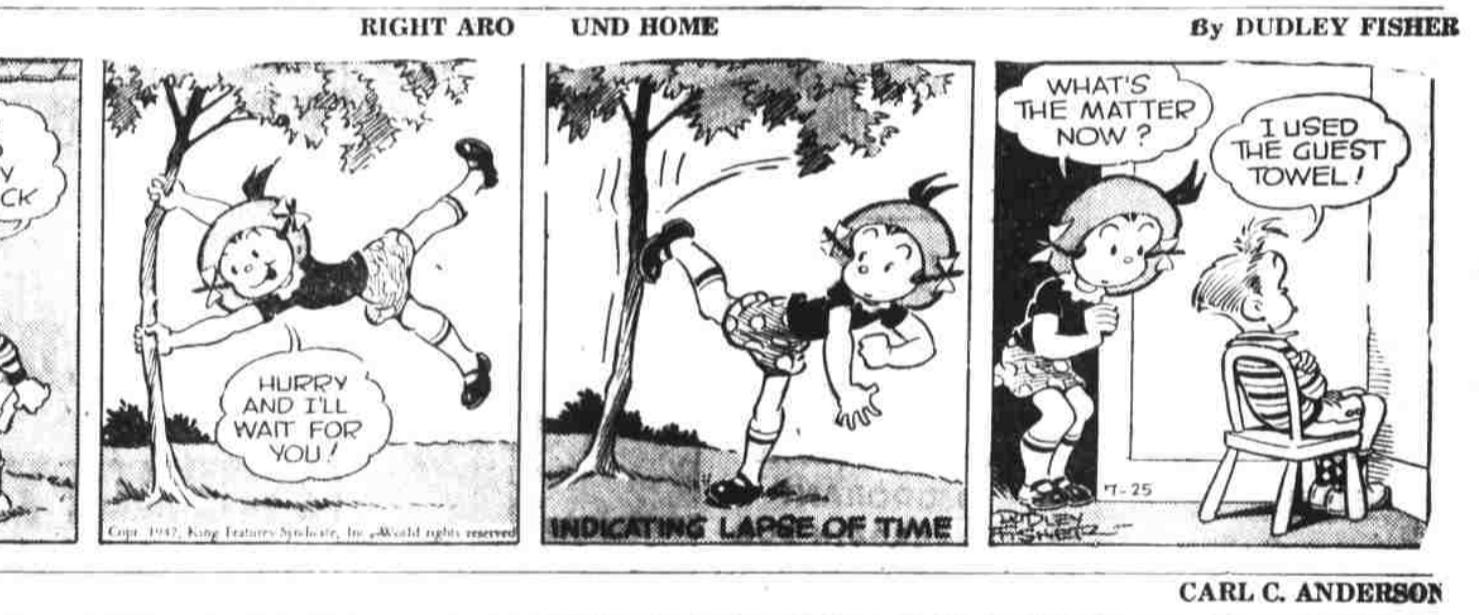

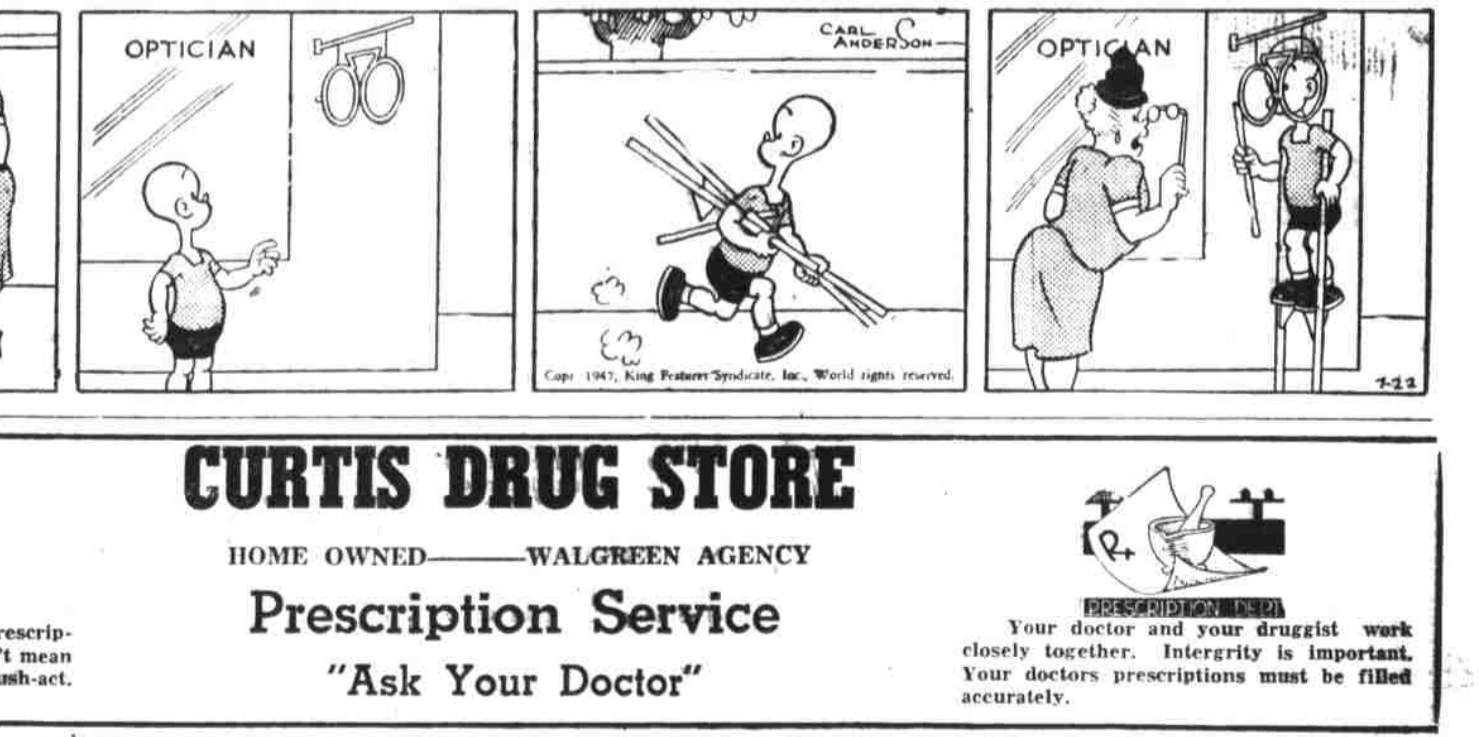
