And they didn't get to keep the birds. The game warden turned the fowl over to a hospital.

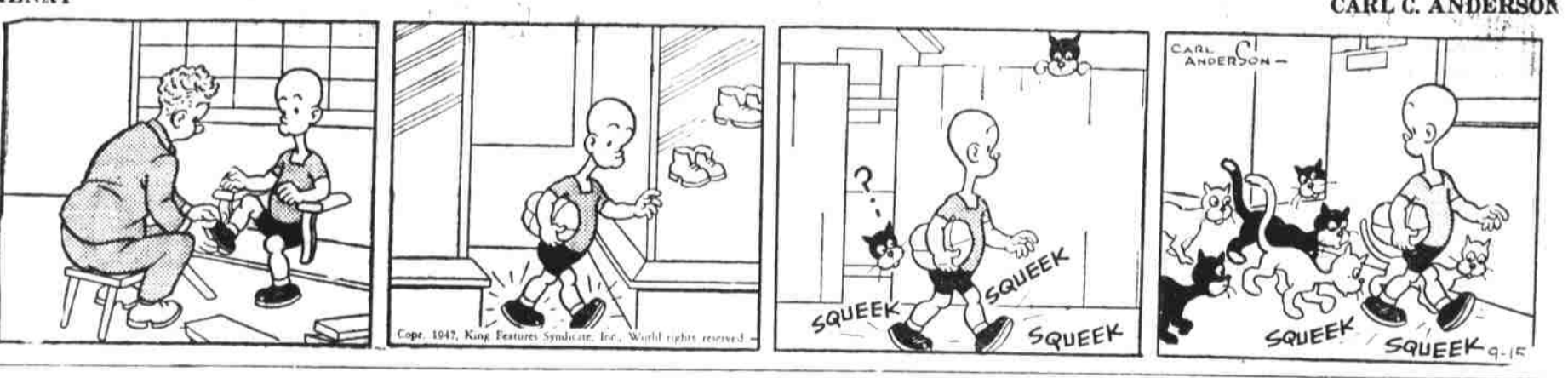
