Mobile Sawmill Devised To Cut Lumbering Costs

BARTOW, Fla. (UP) — Florida industrialists expect a mobile sawmill designed and built by J. W. Huffing to revolutionize the state's lumbering.

The rolling contraption is expected to cut costs by reducing transportation and labor and eliminating installation.

The diesel-powered mill, built on a 30-foot semi-trailer to be pulled by a truck or tractor, can move deep into the woods and be ready to operate in 30 minutes.

Its 18 24-inch circular saws quickly rip a 16-inch log into one-inch board 8 1/2 feet long. Only four men are required for full-speed operation.
