Scripture—Acts 15:36-18:27; I Corinthians 5:9-6:20; II Corinthians 6:11-7:1.



After staying at Antioch for some days, Paul and Barnabas decided to visit the cities where they had made converts. Barnabas wanted to take John Mark with them; Paul did not, so they separated, Barnabas taking John and Paul, Silas.



Coming to Troas in their travels, Paul had a vision in the night of a man who begged him to "Come over into Macedonia and help us," so Paul and his companions, thinking this was word from God, went to Philippi, chief Macedonian city.



At Philippi, Paul and his companions made many converts, but envious Jews took them before the magistrates and they were beaten and imprisoned. An earthquake liberated them, however, their jailer was baptized, and after comforting their brethren, they departed.



From Philippi, Paul went to Thessalonica where he and Silas were taken before a magistrate who released them; then to Athens, where Paul preached the gospel on Mars Hill; and thence to Corinth, a pagan city. MEMORY VERSE—Acts 18:9-10.
