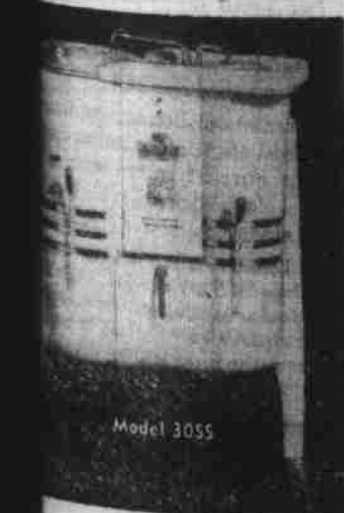

Precinct Meetings Slated For The 29th

Plans are being completed for precinct meetings at each of Haywood's 24 precincts on Saturday, at two o'clock.

The meetings will be held at the polling place of each precinct, according to Mrs. Fred Y. Campbell, acting chairman of the Haywood Democratic Executive Committee.

Plumbing and Heating Contractors are notified that Public Laws of 1931, Chapter 52, as amended by Public Laws of 1933, Chapter 57, will be observed in receiving and awarding plumbing and heating contracts.

Electrical Contractors are notified that provisions of Chapter 57, Public Laws of 1937, ratified March 23rd, will be observed in receiving and awarding contracts.

Each proposal shall be accompanied by a cash deposit or a certified check drawn on some bank or trust company insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corp., of an amount equal to not less than five per cent of the proposal, or in lieu thereof, a bidder may offer a certified check of two per cent of the bid plus a bid bond of three per cent of the bid, said deposit to be retained by the owner as liquidated damages in event of failure of the successful bidder to execute the contract within ten (10) days after the award or to give satisfactory surety as required by law.

Performance Bond will be required for one hundred per cent (100%) of contract price.

Payment will be made on the basis of eighty-five per cent (85%) of monthly estimates, and final payment made upon completion and acceptance of the work.

No bid may be withdrawn after the schedule closing time for the receipt of bids for a period of thirty (30) days.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive informalities.

Essay Contest Deadline April 28 For Schools

Assistant County Agent Turner Cathey, Community Development Program supervisor, issued this memorandum today.

He said the papers of the students who won the local contest in their respective schools must be turned in by that deadline to either County Schools Superintendent Jack Messer or Dr. A. J. Hutchins, superintendent of Canton city schools.

The contest, open to pupils of the sixth grade of all Haywood County Schools, was launched this winter.

The student judged as the county champion will receive the first prize of \$40. The runnerup will get \$30, the student finishing third will receive \$15, while the fourth-place winner will get \$10, and the fifth-place winner, \$5.

The contestants will be judged on how well they tell the story of the "Aims and Objectives of the Haywood Community Development Program."

Applications for residential construction in North Carolina during the first three months of this year were way over the totals for the same period a year ago.

This was reported recently by James McKae, state director for the FHA at Greensboro. Mortgage insurance applications for the first three months of this year covered 89 per cent more homes than those of the corresponding period for 1949. Applications for 3,172 residential units were filed during the first quarter of this year—more than 2,000 above the total for the first quarter of last year.
