Miami at Least, Reports No Housing Shortage

MIAMI, Fla. (UP)—A \$50-a-month apartment in the Miami area is no longer a pre-war myth. The reason is that Miami built more apartments since the war than any other metropolitan area of comparable size. S. Oliver O'Bryan, president of the Greater Miami apartment house association, estimated that more than 26,000 of the 150,000 rental units in the Miami area are vacant. There will be even more available this summer, he predicted. Miami daily newspapers were carrying such attractive advertisements as this one: "Garage efficiency apartment. Includes all. Coral Gables, \$37.50 monthly."

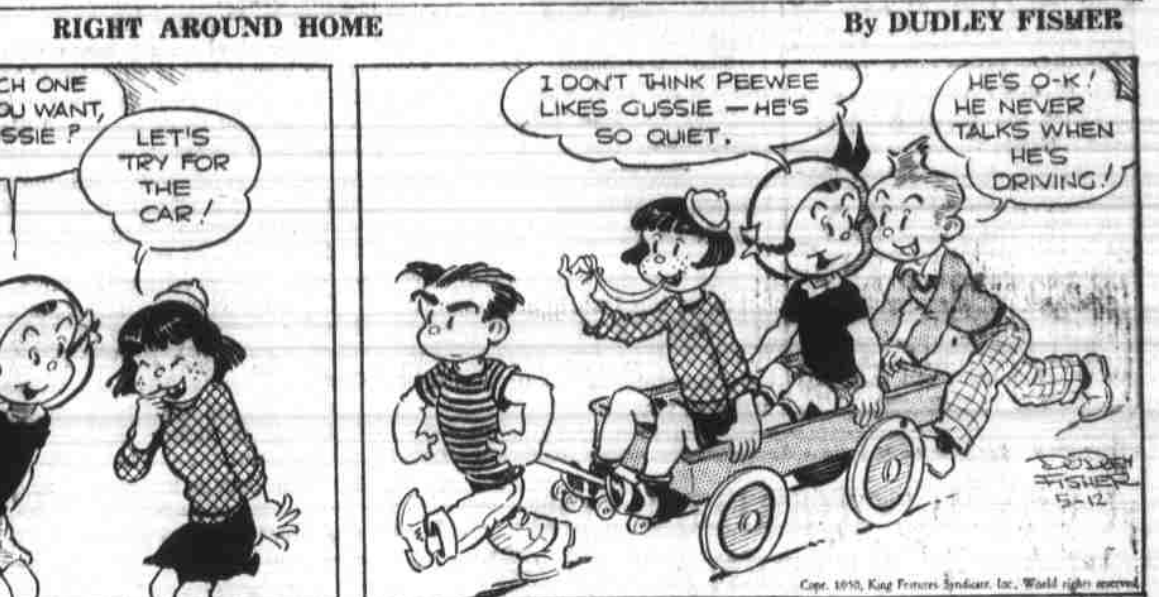
