## Our School Needs

As foreman of your grand jury in 1948, I am happy to give some excerpts of our official report on schools:

1-Waynesville High School Building-buildings over crowded, unsanitary, badty in need of additional janitor service, having only one janiter for three buildings and 1,090 students. High school lunch room is too small for the number of students served. At present 840 are served and the room seats 75 people.

3-Bethel School-we go on record for a new central high school at Bethel, the present one is not sanitary, is a fire hazard, and inadequate in every respect. This school building is a disgrace to the great citizenry of te

The above was our report, and I am PROUD to say "Help For These Schools Is On The Way," and in the future the needs which we revealed in our report will in some measure be corrected.
