Methodist Hospital Group To Meet At Lake On Ninth

The 1950 conference of Methodist Hospital and Home leaders will be held July 9-12 at Lake Junaluska, Judge Marcus C. Redwine, of Winchester, Ky., chairman of the Southeastern Jurisdictional Board of Hospitals and Homes of The Methodist Church, has announced.

Attending will be leaders of 12 hospitals, 12 homes for the aged and 12 homes for children affiliated with The Methodist Church located within the nine southeastern states comprising the Southeastern Jurisdiction of The Methodist Church. These leaders will be joined by representatives of Methodist hospitals and homes in other parts of the nation, officials of the church's General Board of Hospitals and Homes, and members of the Southeastern Jurisdictional Board.

Delegates will hear addresses by episcopal and executive leaders of The Methodist Church and will participate in panel and workshop discussions on various phases of hospital and home administration.

Bishop Charles W. Brashares, resident bishop of the Des Moines (Iowa) Area of The Methodist Church and first vice president of the General Board, will discuss "The Importance of Close Relationship Between the Church and Methodist Hospitals and Homes," Monday morning, July 10, in the opening session.

Also addressing the conference on Monday morning will be Dr. Robert Burton House, Chancellor of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. His subject is "The Church's Relation to Wealth, Commonweal and Compassion."

Two platform speakers will be heard Monday night. Dr. Ralph Stood of New York, executive director of Methodist Information, will speak on "Developing a Public Relations Program in a Methodist Hospital or Home". Hon. Donald W. Shriver, of Norfolk, will speak on "Our Churches and Our Institutions."
