'Peggy' Brings Colorful Rose Tourney To Screen

Combining the colorful pageantry of Pasadena's world-famous New Year's Day Rose Parade with a barrel of howling belly-laughs, Universal-International's Technicolor "Peggy," coming to the Strand Theatre Sunday, emerges as one of the brightest comedies of the year.

With the present trend in Hollywood pointing toward semi-documentary film fare, it is puzzling why the moviemakers haven't pointed their cameras at the Pasadena Tournament of Roses before this. The great flower-covered floats, bands and horsemen, plus the climactic Rose Bowl football game, which are fitted into the story of "Peggy," become top-notch entertainers under the skilled hand of Director Frederick deCordova.

Luscious Diana Lynn, in the title role, gives a piquant performance as the contestant for Rose Queen honors who doesn't want to win. Monocled Charles Coburn again proves why he is one of Hollywood's greatest assets in the comedy role of the frustrated father. Charlotte Greenwood scores again and again with her role as the domineering next-door neighbor who won't take "No" for an answer. Barbara Lawrence, who portrays Diana Lynn's sister, exudes vivacity as the girl who eventually becomes Rose Queen.
