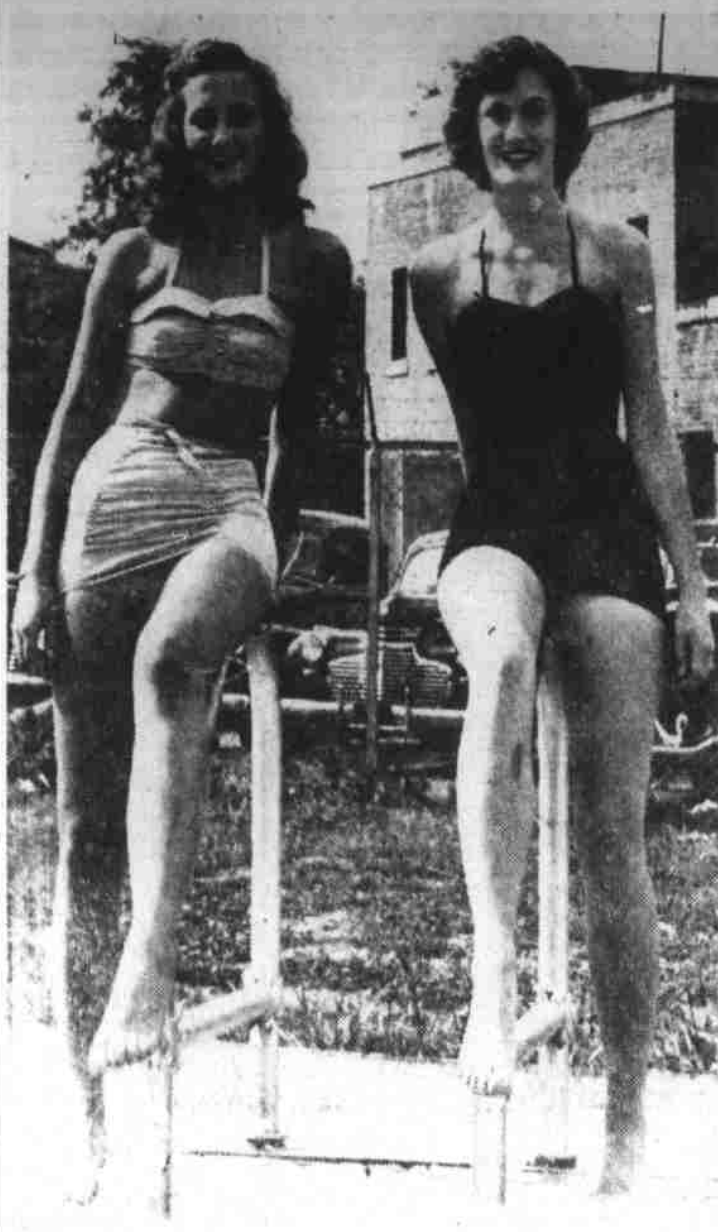

Annual Apple Festival To Attract Big Crowds Into Henderson County

North Carolina folk, especially home folks of the western portion of the state, will kick up their heels upon opening date of the North Carolina Apple Festival scheduled to begin in Hendersonville Thursday, August 31, and continue through Labor Day, September 4.

The first evening will be a Folk Dance Feature, beginning at 7:30 p.m. Hendersonville High Stadium, with some of the finest square dance teams and bands, ballad singers and specialty artists, ever assembled in this part of the state, performing for the championship of their respective classifications.

Friday night will find the same thing going on with a different group of performers, all competing for the championship finals of Saturday evening, September 2. Some 100 performers will be on the stage during the course of each evening during this folk dance series of events.

An orchard tour given Friday morning, September 1, starting at 9:30 a.m.—This will be open for home folks and visitors alike with transportation where needed.

An important feature of Saturday, September 2, will be the "Dutch" Luncheon meeting of apple growers, 1:00 p.m., at the Home Food Shop Cafeteria. The principal reason of this meeting is for the purpose of going on record, if not to organize, the North Carolina Horticultural Society. Apply growers from all counties are invited to be present.

The evening of September 2 will see the selection of the queen at the time of the championship folk

finals, at 9:00 p.m. For the public, and particularly visitors to Western North Carolina, there will be an opportunity for golf play in a tournament arranged for 1:00 p.m., September 3, at the Hendersonville Golf and Country Club. The Peoria system will be used.

One of the finest features of the Festival will be the Flower Show sponsored by the Rugby Garden Club, which will be held the afternoons and evenings of September 2 and September 3, beginning at 1:00 p.m., and lasting until 10:00 p.m., at the French Broad Baptist Church Recreation House on Highway 191 at Mills River.

The dairy interest will have their day in the form of a Junior Dairy Show scheduled for 1:30 p.m., September 4, at the Western North Carolina Fair Grounds just out of Hendersonville.

Music lovers will find a treat in the band concert arranged for Labor Day afternoon at 2:30 p.m. This will be put on by the Eusta Band under the direction of John Eversman and the Hendersonville Band under the direction of Earl Martin.

Immediately following the band concert, these bands will form an honor guard for the queen who will be paraded down Main Street upon a beautiful combination float of apples and gladiolus to a 4:00 p.m. Street Dance on Main Street between the blocks of Third Avenue and Fourth Avenue.

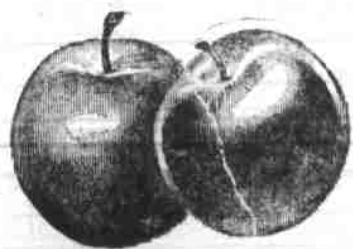
