## Inside Story Of Marshal Rommel Related By Movie

There's more evidence than peace treaties that World War II is well behind us. Now comes a movie, "The Desert Fox," which purports to be a revealing close-up of the German field marshal, Erwin Rommel.

The sympathetic study, based on Desmond Young's best-seller, "Rommel," is generally absorbing screen fare. It should offend few who have bitter war memories, for it concentrates on Rommel's gradual conversion to the cause of destroying Hitler. For participating in the abortive plot, Rommel himself is shown to have met with disaster.

The film's biggest asset is an excellent cast headed by James Mason as the shrewd professional soldier, Jessica Tandy plays his wife, Cedric Hardwicke is a prime mover in the conspiracy, and Luther Adler is a suitably hysterical Hitler. Battle scenes include actual combat footage and simulated warfare on the Southern California desert.

"Reunion in Reno" is a slow-starting concoction that finally manages to jerk a few tears. Reno Divorce Lawyer Mark Stevens, a handsome man with a pipe, has a startling caller one day. Nine-year-old Gigi Perreau wants a divorce from her parents.

She won't tell what city she's from. She won't drop the slightest hint of why she wants to be rid of her folks. That, I think is why she takes so long to snag your sympathy. Stevens and his stenographer, Peggy Dow, out to find her parents, meanwhile sparring romantically with each other.

Frances Dee and Leif Erickson are the parents, and Ray Collins is a nice old judge. But little Gigi steals the picture.

"Silver City," one of the slug-ginest, slam-bangiest westerns of late, has Assayor Edmond O'Brien trying to help Yvonne De Carlo run her mine. Barry Fitzgerald, Richard Arlen, and several sullen muscle men are their enemies. Newcomer Laura Elliott, as the mean other woman, is another flaw in the ore of pure love.

Fluttery, plump Josephine Hull steals "The Lady from Texas" as a balmy lady rancher. Tough Howard Duff and pert Mona Freeman try to save her from enemies who want to have her declared insane. A climatic open-air trial, presided over by Judge Gen. Lockhart, is rather beautiful; it may even moisten your eye.

MORE THAN 35,000 PERSONS have been deported since May 21, 1951, from Budapest to the Hungarian provinces to live in police-dominated communities. The deportees include former land owners, industrialists and businessmen whose plants and shops have been "nationalized," and professional men. Hungarian Jews make up a large percentage of the deportees. Those remaining behind in Budapest besiege the Israeli Legation hoping to get immigration certificates as insurance against seizure. These certificates guarantee that Israel will accept bearers as immigrants. At top, a mother leans over her infant at a legation table to fill out the necessary application.
