That He may establish thee today for a people unto Himself, and that He may be unto thee a God, as He hath said unto thee, and as He hath sworn unto thy fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and

to Jacob." Moses' heart must have almost failed him when he thought of the past history of this people during these 40 years. How would it be when he was gone and they felt that God was not so close

to them? After the reading, Moses told his people that he was an old man, 120 that day, and he was unable to "go out and come in: also the Lord hath said unto me, Thou shalt not go over this

Jordan." "The Lord thy God, He will go over before thee and He will destroy these nations from before thee, and thou shalt possess them: and Joshua, he shall go over be-

fore thee, as the Lord hath said." To Joshua, who was to take his place, this wise, venerable and courageous leader addressed the words, "Be strong and of a good courage; fear not, nor be afraid | face."

world God had told Moses to go up into the mount and He would show him the land that was to be the home of his people, and then he would die. First, however, Moses blessed the children of Israel, and then he "went up from the plains of Moab unto the mountain of Nebo, to the top of Pisgah ... and the Lord showed him all the land of Gilead unto Dan. And all Naphtali, and the land of Ephraim, and Manasseh, and all the land of Judah, unto

the utmost sea. "And the south, and the plain of Jericho, the city of palm trees, unto Zoar.

"And the Lord said unto him: This is the land which I sware unto Abraham, unto Isaac, and unto Jacob, saying, I will give it unto thy seed: I have caused thee to see it with thine eyes, but thou shalt not go over thither."
