BOND ORDER AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$2,000,000 SCHOOL BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF HAYWOOD.

WHEREAS, the governing bodies of the Haywood County School Administrative Unit and of the Canton Graded School District Trustees have determined that it is necessary to provide additional school plant facilities in said units, described in this bond order, so that the public schools in the County of Haywood may be maintained, as a part of the system of public schools of the State of North Carolina, for the term required by the Constitution of North Carolina, and that it will be necessary to expend for such school plant facilities in such units the respective sums hereinafter appropriated thereto, in addition to other moneys available therefor; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Haywood as follows:

Section 1. Bonds of the County of Haywood are hereby authorized and shall be issued pursuant to The County Finance Act of North Carolina to finance the cost of erecting new school houses, physical education and vocational education buildings and lunch rooms, and of erecting additions to and altering and reconstructing existing school houses, physical education and vocational education buildings and lunch rooms and of acquiring land and purchasing furnishings and equipment required for such school plant facilities. The maximum aggregate principal amount of said bonds shall be Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000).

Section 2. \$1,394,300 of the moneys to be raised by the issuance of said bonds shall be expended for and is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of such school plant facilities in said Haywood County School Administrative Unit, \$605,800 of the moneys to be raised by the issuance of said bonds shall be expended for and is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of such school plant facilities in said Canton Graded School District.

Section 3. The Board of County Commissioners has ascertained and hereby determines that it is necessary to provide such additional school plant facilities described in his bond order so that said County may maintain public schools in aid County, as an administrative agency of the public school system of the State of North Carolina.

for the term required by the Constitution of North Carolina, and that it will be necessary to expend for such school plant facilities in each of said units the respective sums hereinafter appropriated thereto, in addition to other moneys available therefor.

Section 4. A tax sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on said bonds when due shall be annually levied and collected.

Section 5. A statement of the County debt of the County of Haywood has been filed with the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of said County and is open to public inspection.

Section 6. This bond order shall take effect when approved by the voters of the County at an election as provided in said Act.

The foregoing bond order was finally passed on October 29, 1951, and was first published on December 13, 1951. Any action or proceeding questioning the validity of said bond order must be commenced within thirty days after its first publication.

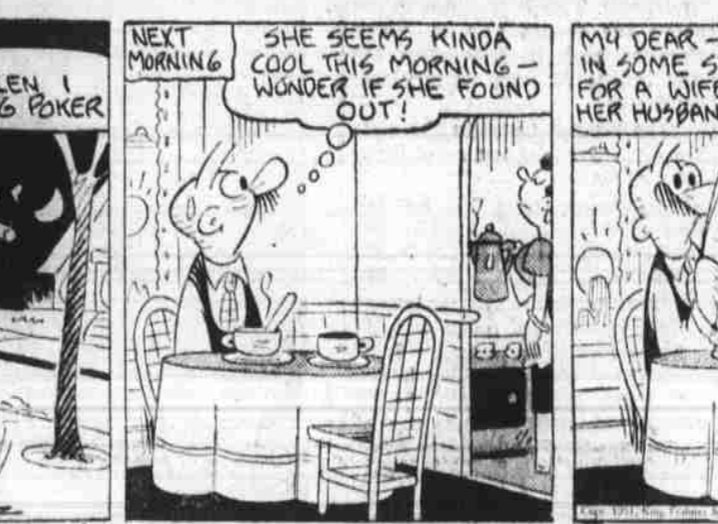

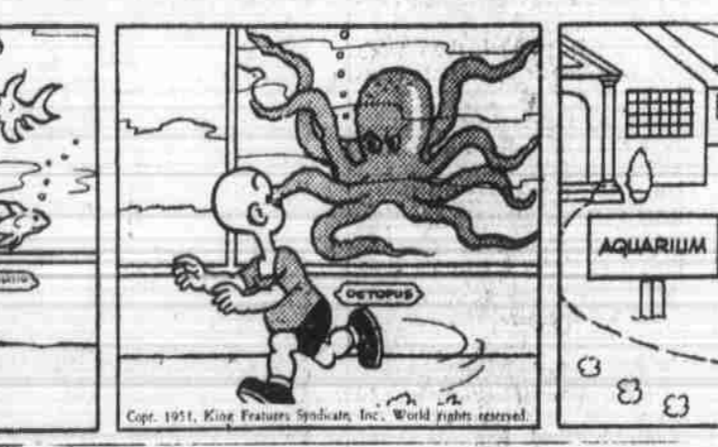
