Jesus told a parable about a man whose harvests were so rich that he decided to store his goods and take life easy, but God told him that he would die that night, so his riches would do him no good.



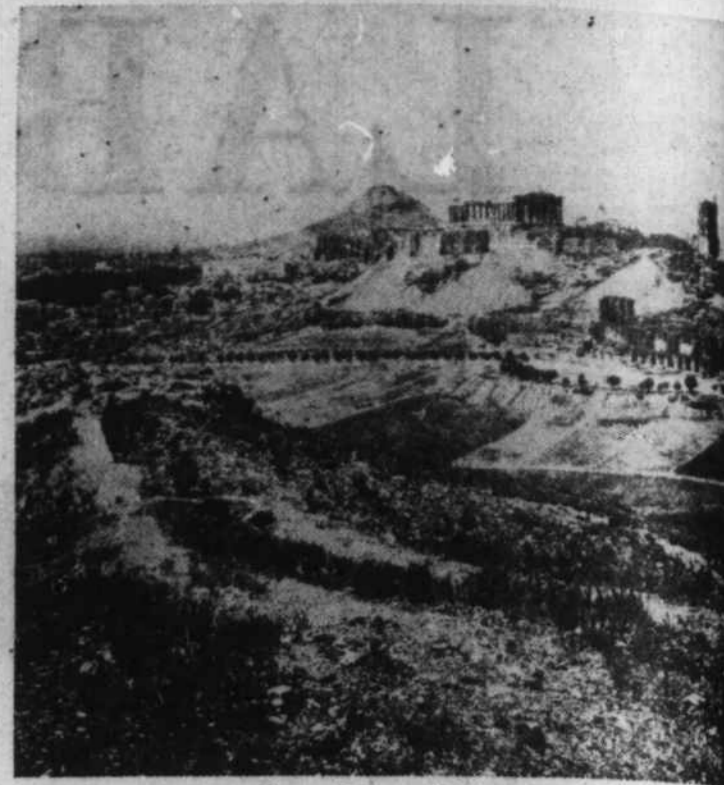
