Breakfast Dish with Bananas

For something substantial to bolster captious eaters, try Ba-nana French Toast or Strawberry Flavored With Nutmeg

mixture, turning to coat both sides. Brown bread on both sides in ¼ c. shortening in a skillet. Slice 3 medium bananas and place a layer of fruit on each of 4 slices of French toast. Cover with second slice of French toast.

Combine 2 slightly beaten eggs. WE'D like to remind our friends that a good breakfast is just as important during warm weather as it is the rest of the year. Very often, the family plans to be absent from home much of the day, and the knowledge that they go forth fortified with a good meal is of great comfort to the homemaker.


