#### NOTICE OF ORDINANCE PROHIBITING SMOKING IN THEATRES

Department-Phone 6-3539.)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Waynesville:

Section 1. That it shall be un lawful for any person to Smoke in any theatre building, motion picture house or house of public amusement while patrons are in said building, previous to, during or immediately after any show or gathering for public amusement.

Section 2. Any person violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined the sum of FIFTY DOLLARS for each and every offense.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on and after January 1st, 1954.
