Another in the series of summer concerts will be presented on the stage of the main auditorium at Lake Junaluska Saturday at 8 p.m. Miss Evelyn McGarrity, mezzo-soprano, will appear in a program of classical and familiar music.

Miss McGarrity is a graduate of Wesleyan Conservatory in Macon, Ga., and the Curtis Institute of Music in Philadelphia, Pa. She has appeared on tour with the Broadway company of Gian-Sarlo Menotti's "The Consul" and was soloist with the Robert Shaw Chorale for the American premiere of Francis Poulenc's "Stabat Mater" in Carnegie Hall. Miss McGarrity has recently returned from Italy where she studied on a Fulbright scholarship and made her operatic debut in "Madame Butterfly." Three Biblical songs by Dvorak.

U. S. Makes Change In Price For Mica

Prices paid for mica purchased under the government's Program B will be changed, effective at 4 p.m. Friday, according to W. E. Harman, Jr., of Atlanta, regional director of the General Services Administration.

New maximum prices for handcolbed mica delivered to and accepted by the government will be: (1) \$600 per actual short ton for

ruby handcolbed mica, \$550 per actual short ton for ruby handcolbed mica. These are maximums to be paid for mica delivered to the government in lots of more than 10,000 pounds of stained and better mica.
