Scripture—Luke 22:1-71.



As the Passover neared the chief priests and scribes pondered on a way to get Jesus into their power that they might kill Him. Judas Iscariot, tempted by Satan, went to them offering to betray Him for money.



Peter and John were sent by Jesus to prepare the Passover. They would meet a man bearing a pitcher of water on his head. Following him to a house, the owner would show them the room in which to hold the Passover.



At table Christ passed the disciples the wine, broke bread and gave it to them, saying the wine was His blood, shed for them; the bread His body broken for them, adding "This do in remembrance of Me."



Jesus declared that one of the 12 would betray Him. Peter vowed he would go to prison or death with his Master, but Christ said Peter would deny Him thrice ere the cock crowed.
