Revives Ancient Tongue

SEATTLE, Wash. (AP)—A Seattle diamond merchant spends his spare time trying to reassemble an ancient language which he says might be called the "grandmother of Hebrew." Arthur Lagavier already knows 17 languages. He holds a doctorate in philosophy and a rabbinical degree.

When his family was forced by the Nazis to leave Antwerp, Belgium, he managed to save his collection of 6,000 books. He has been teaching Hebrew literature at the University of Washington and spending much of his time in scholarly study. One of his hobbies is delving into the mysteries of Ugaritic, a language he says was in use probably 2,000 years before Christ.

"It is the language from which was developed Phoenician, forerunner of Hebrew," he says.

Tablets bearing the strange writings of the ancient kingdom of Ugarit, in northern Syria, were unearthed in 1928. Lagavier received photostats of them three years ago. From the inscriptions, he is trying to develop a Ugaritic grammar.
