FORT KNOX, Ky.—Pvt. Palmer B. Caldwell, 18, son of Mr. and Mrs. Hardy Caldwell, Route 4, is scheduled to leave the U. S. for Germany late next month as part of Operation Gyroscope, the Army's unit rotation plan.

His unit, the 3d Armored Division, now stationed at Fort Knox, Ky., will replace the 4th Infantry Division in Europe.

Caldwell is a tank crewman in Company D of the division's 709th Tank Battalion.

He has been in the Army since July 1955.

press upon the people the inadequacy of our facilities for handling the mentally deficient. They point out that in this state there are between 85,000 and 90,000 school children who are physically handicapped, hard of hearing, defective in speech, emotionally mal-adjusted, or mentally retarded. Of this number, 20,000 are so severely affected that they are, or should be, in institutions.

Last year more than 300 children were held in the jails in this state because there were not adequate facilities for them in our state institutions. For the same reason, an average of 115 mental patients per month are being held in our jails.

All citizens of Haywood County are being urged to add their support to the Mental Health Association by becoming members of the association, by disseminating educational materials, and by encouraging the expansion of our present facilities for handling the handicapped.

Speculation Rife On Further Route Of Pigeon Road

Haywood residents who have been following the progress of the Pigeon River road find that their interest continues as speculation increases as to the route the road will follow after it leaves the river near Clyde.

In commenting on the possible routes, the Hendersonville Tribune suggests several possibilities. It states: "The largest number of speculators say that the new route will follow the present Clyde-Canton-Asheville road to Enka, cross over to N. C. 191, through Mills River to the prison camp just north of Hendersonville, and perhaps skirt Hendersonville on the north and east." The paper continues that from a point east of Hendersonville the highway may divide, with one prong heading toward Greenville and the other toward Charlotte.

"Another idea," the Tribune says, "is that the highway will miss the Hendersonville area entirely, that it will leave the Clyde-Canton area, head across the mountain to Brevard and on toward Greenville." This idea may have stemmed from the wartime proposal of tunneling under Pisgah Ridge upriver from the Pigeon River bridge and emerging near the ranger station on the Transylvania side.

"Another alternative is to follow the established route from Clyde to Asheville or an entirely new route between the two points."

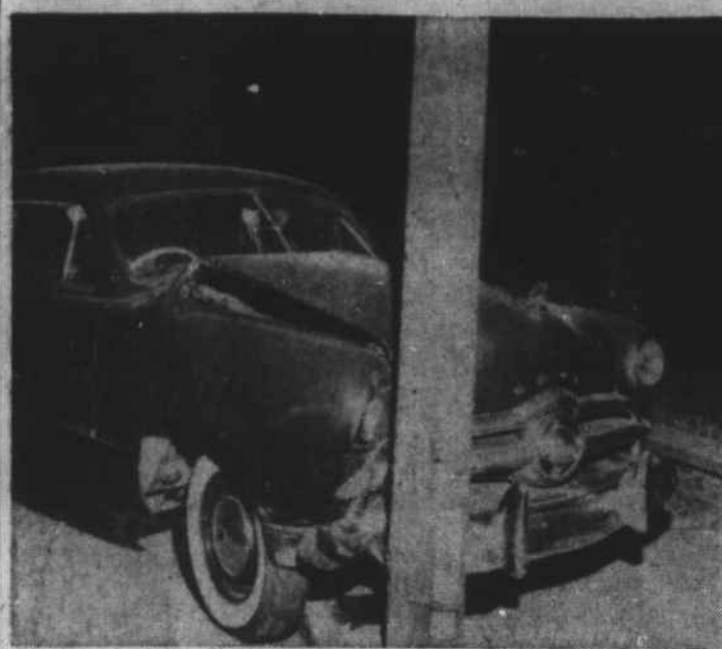
The Hendersonville paper concludes, however with a word of caution: "There might not be any plans for additional construction this side of Clyde . . . the route to Waterville is simply a new passage into Tennessee."
