Grave Robbing

(By the Associated Press) Ted Wells, 18, of Asheville, has been charged with grave-robbing, police said, as a result of a sack of human bones being found in the trunk of an abandoned car on Soco Gap about two weeks ago,

Sgt. E. W. Jones of the State Highway Patrol said Wells admitted digging up the bones in the backyard of a friend while burying

Jones said Wells told the patrol that an unmarked grave turned up during the digging in the back yard of a friend, Harold Fuller of Asheville. The sergeant said Wells removed a skull, ribs and leg bones and put them in a sack in the back of his car,

The car broke down when he and Fuller were visiting Fuller's relatives in Bryson City. They abandoned the car on Soco Gap
