E. W. Jones of the State Highway Patrol said Wells admitted digging up the bones in the backyard of a friend while burying a fox. Jones said Wells told the patrol that an unmarked grave turned up during the digging in the back yard of a friend, Harold Fuller of Asheville. The sergeant said Wells removed a skull, ribs and leg bones and put them in a sack in the back of his car. The car broke down when he and Fuller were visiting Fuller's relatives in Bryson City. They abandoned the car on Soco Gap.
