

# Mountaineers End Season Friday With Brevard; Bearcats Win 1-0 Duel

In a pitchers' duel Monday night, the Mountaineers dropped their fourth game of the season and the second straight to Hendersonville in a hard-fought 1-0 battle.

Both Waynesville's George Mitchell and Hendersonville's Bill Davis gave up only two hits, but the Bearcats put together two hits and a walk for the winning run. Mitchell struck out seven, Davis 11.

In the sixth inning, Hendersonville got the lone run on a single by James McCall, a double by Don Hellig, a walk by Charles Sproles, and a grounder by Doyle Mintz.

The Mountaineers will close out their 1956 season here Friday afternoon against Brevard. In the first meeting this year between the two foes, Waynesville shut out the Blue Devils, 8-0.
