CONDITIONAL SALES

What is a conditional sales con-

It is a type of contract used by many persons in buying items of personal property on the installment plan. It enables the buyer to get immediate possession of the property on his promise that he will pay the full purchase price later in certain specified installments. Although the buyer acouires possession, the seller retains the title or ownership of the property until the last payment is

Merchants frequently attract the attention of customers by advertising the conditional sales contract security device as the "easy payment plan," "budget plan," "deferred payment plan," or "dignifled credit plan."

If the conditional buyer misses one of his payments, may the seller take the property back?

Yes. If the conditional buyer fails to make any payment when it is due, the seller can repossess or take back the property.




